[Pittsburgh Public Schools](#)

- Grab and Go meals will be available at all 54 school locations from 11:00 AM – 1:00 PM Monday through Friday. Students are instructed to go to the school location closest to their home.

[Keystone Oaks School District](#)

A bagged lunch and milk will be offered free to any child 18 years of age or younger; the child does not have to be eligible for the Free & Reduced Meal program in order to receive a free lunch during this school closure.

[Northgate School District](#)

The Northgate School District will begin offering free “Grab & Go” meals to ALL students in the district beginning Tuesday, March 17th. The meals will consist of a lunch and breakfast for the next day. 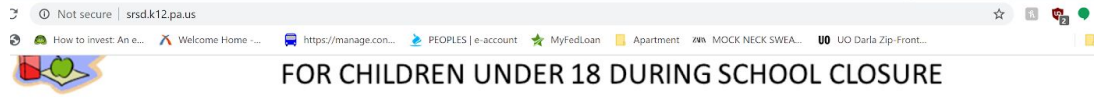
