For COMMITTEE MEMBERS-

Hello, my name is _____, and I'm a constituent from [City/Town], **or** I'm calling on behalf of [Organization].

I'm calling to urge Senator _____ to vote YES on SB 760 in committee.

SB 760 would require radon testing and, when needed, mitigation in Pennsylvania schools. Radon is the number one cause of lung cancer among never-smokers and the second leading cause of lung cancer overall, and a serious but **preventable** health risk- especially for children and school staff who spend long hours in these buildings.

Right now, many schools across Pennsylvania are not testing for radon, which means families and educators may be unknowingly exposed.

I understand that SB 760 does not yet include funding, but a companion bill in the House has already passed out of committee with a funding amendment. Moving SB 760 forward now ensures the Senate is ready to act as the funding solution advances.

As a member of the committee, the Senator's vote is critical at this stage. I'm asking the Senator to:

- **Vote YES on SB 760 in committee, and**
- **Support efforts to align the bill with funding as it progresses**
